



Cooperation Agreement



Between

The Cambodian Center for Study and Development in Agriculture, hereafter « CEDAC », a Cambodian Non-Government Association registered at the Ministry of Interior on 20th April 1998, n° 310 located at # 119, St. 257, Khan Tuol Kork, Phnom Penh, Cambodia
Represented by Dr. Yang Saing Koma, President

And

The Research and Technological Exchange Group, hereafter "GRET", an association under the French law of 1901, registered No 309 123 057 00031 CODE APE 913 E, located at # 22, St. 330, Boeung Keng Kang III, Phnom Penh, Cambodia
Represented by Dr. Cédric Salze, Country Representative

Having seen:

- The Memorandum of Understanding between CEDAC and GRET signed on 04/07/2007.
- The Partnership Agreement between CEDAC and GRET signed on 13/07/2009 about the implementation for the ASIrri project.
- The contract between CEDAC and ExCom Mundolkiri for the creation of one FWUC for Mchu Nga scheme in Mundolkiri province, signed on 05 March 2010.

It has been agreed that:

Article 1 Scope of the contract

This contract is to define the conditions for collaboration between GRET and CEDAC for the establishment of a Farmer Water User Community (FWUC) for the management of Machunga dam in Royor Commune, Koah Nhek District, Mondulkiri Province according to the detailed Technical Service Proposal in annex of this contract.

Article 2 CEDAC responsibilities

CEDAC is responsible for the project financial management, the technical and financial reporting to the ExCom Mundolkiri province.

Article 3 GRET responsibilities

GRET will mobilize the Irrigation Service Centre team recruited under the ASIrri project to ensure the following positions for the Machunga project:

- Technical Advisor 14 days
- One village facilitator 49 days

- One local newly recruited village facilitator 49 days

The ISC will be responsible for all travel costs, per-diem and accomodation for staff, and service implementation costs, except for the salaries of CEDAC staff involved in the project implementation.

Article 4 Financial management and payment procedure

CEDAC will pay directly to the Irrigation Service Centre bank account a total amount of **20,000 US** dollars (twenty thousands) with three different instalments after a written request sent to CEDAC by ISC and only after CEDAC received the installed payments from ExCom Mondulkiri as agreed in the contract between CEDAC and ExCom.

Article 5 Resolution of conflicts

Any conflict arising between CEDAC and GRET shall initially be discussed within the ASIrri project Management Committee. In case it can not be solved at this level, the senior representatives of GRET (Paris) and CEDAC will join efforts to solve it amicably and based on the spirit of the signed Memorandum of Understanding of the two parties.

Article 6 Duration of the contract

This agreement is valid from 1st April 2010 to 31st December 2010. Amendments can be made at any time by mutual agreement. It can be terminated by any of the parties involved, by a letter addressed with a three months previous notice.
